

LIVE GREEN TORONTO MEMBERSHIP CARD PROGRAM CARDHOLDER AGREEMENT

INTRODUCTION

1. The Live Green Toronto Membership Card Program (the "Program") connects approved city of Toronto retailers, service providers, distributors and other eligible businesses (the "Business") with individuals who hold valid Live Green Toronto Membership Cards (the "Member").
2. A Member is entitled to receive an exclusive promotion, special offer and/or direct discount (the "Benefits") when he or she shops at an approved Business.
3. The Member must hold and demonstrate a valid Live Green Toronto Membership Card (the "Card") in order to be eligible for the Benefits.
4. The approved Business list and Benefits are provided on the Program web site – livegreencard.ca.
5. The Program is part of the City of Toronto's Live Green Toronto Program, and is administered by the Environment and Energy Office (the "City").

ELIGIBILITY

6. To be eligible for the Program, the Member must:
 - i. be at least 14 years of age; and
 - ii. live, work and/or shop in the city of Toronto.
7. The Card is for individual use only. Business corporations, joint ventures, partnerships, groups, or associations may not register.
8. The City reserves the right to refuse any applicant or terminate any Member who does not comply with the terms and conditions contained in this agreement.

PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM

9. Membership in the Program is free. The Card holds no monetary value and is not a debit, credit, or payment card.
10. To become a Member, the applicant must visit livegreentoronto.ca where the applicant can complete and submit the on-line Card application form. The applicant shall certify that all

information given in the on-line Card application form is true, accurate and complete in all respects. Any false or misleading information given in this application and any accompanying materials may result in rejection of the Card application or revocation of the Card.

11. The applicant, if approved as a Member, is issued one (1) Card.
12. The Card is non-transferable.
13. The Member can use the Card only at a participating Business.
14. To receive Benefits, the Member must present his or her Card to the cashier of the Business before the purchase transaction is completed.
15. An original Card must be presented at the time of purchase; a facsimile will not be accepted.
16. The Benefits are offered to the Member at the sole discretion of the Business. The Business may cease to honour Benefits without prior notice. Benefits may also be subject to change without prior notice. For an updated list of Benefits, Members should refer to the Program web site livegreencard.ca
17. At the discretion of the City, new replacement Cards or a different type of card may be issued to replace the existing Card. All Cards remain the property of the City and must be returned upon request.

CLAIMS AND DISPUTES

18. All claims or disputes between the Business and Member shall be settled directly between the Business and the Member. The Member may contact the City to provide comments about the Program, but the City is not obligated to follow-up, investigate or mediate any claim or dispute between the Business and the Member.
19. The City makes no endorsement, representation or warranty, express or implied, relating to the competence, quality, or suitability of any Business or the Benefits offered by the Business as part of the Program. To become an approved Business, the Business applies to the City, completes a self-assessment and submits a list of the Benefits to be provided to Members. It is the responsibility of the Member to perform his or her own due diligence into the claims made by the Business and the merits of the products or services provided as the Benefits.

SPECIAL OFFERS

20. On occasion the City may communicate e-mail updates including special offers, information and services to Members. Any Member who does not wish to receive these updates may contact the Program at livegreencard@toronto.ca to unsubscribe and stop receiving e-mail updates.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

By receipt and use of the Card, the Member:

21. accepts the terms and conditions contained in this cardholder agreement;
22. acknowledges that the Card is the property of the City and it must be returned upon request;
23. will notify the City of the loss, theft, or unauthorized use of the card; and
24. will notify the City if the Member is canceling or is no longer a participant in the Program.

CUSTOMER SERVICE (LOST CARDS)

25. Each Member will be issued one Card. If the issued Card is lost or stolen, the Member must contact the Program by email to livegreencard@toronto.ca. The Member will be issued one free replacement Card. Any further requests for additional cards may be declined.

RELEASE

26. The Member, by accepting the terms and conditions contained in this agreement, agrees to assume all responsibility for participation in the Program. The City makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, relating to any Benefit or the availability, competence, quality or financial status of any Business providing such Benefits. The Member agrees to waive and release the City, its officials, officers, employees, agents and representatives from and against any claims or liabilities whatsoever including, without limitation, any damages, costs and liability for any and all loss, injury or damage to any property or person, whether direct, special, consequential, indirect or of any other nature, in connection with or related to the Member's participation in the Program.

CHANGING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

27. The City may restrict, suspend or otherwise alter any aspect of the Program without notice. Any material changes to these Terms and Conditions will be posted online and a copy of the Terms and Conditions will be made available at each participating business, upon request. The online version of the Terms and Conditions is the governing version. If there are any inconsistencies between the online version of the Terms and Conditions and any other version, the online version shall prevail. OTHER TERMS

28. Any unauthorized reproduction of the Card will lead to forfeiture of membership in the Program.
29. If any of these terms and conditions is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions are not affected and are valid and enforceable.
30. The failure of the City to enforce any term or covenant or obligation of the Member contained in the Terms and Conditions is not a waiver of the term, covenant or obligation or permission for any subsequent breach and the City may at any time enforce such term, covenant or obligation.

COLLECTION, USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

31. The *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the "Act") applies to all information collected by the City. The information will only be collected, used and disclosed in accordance with the Act. The information, supplied by the Member, will be collected and used for the proper administration of the Program.
